- 3) **Safe Parking Program:** For CHOA to find a path forward after Foothill Unity Center put this on hold.
- 4) **Lucile parcel:** As this parcel is transitioning from the County back to the City of Arcadia, for this to **remain for as Affordable Housing**, for developer to be chosen, maybe even San Gabriel Valley Habitat for Humanity to build 8 units for first time home-owners.
